

HOW TO USE THIS PACKET

This online copy of the NARTREK Bronze Achievement Level packet is part of a special NARTREK promotion. With this packet, any NAR member can try out the NARTREK program with no advance payment!

Here's how it works:

- Print out this Bronze packet.
- Following the directions, make your qualifying flights for each of the required achievements and obtain the required signatures.

At this point, if you enjoyed the program and would like to receive your official Bronze recognition material and/or continue with the Silver level:

- Attach the required documentation and photos for your flights.
- Fill out the "I Tried It And I Liked It" application form provided.
- Make out a check to "NARTREK" and include it in the packet. Fees are:
 - \$5 to receive your Bronze recognition only;
 - \$10 to receive your Bronze recognition and begin your Silver level;
 - \$20 to receive your Bronze recognition and sign up for Silver, Gold, and one advanced level of your choice (special price offer).

Bronze Achievement Level

Welcome to the NARTREK program! We are happy that you have become a part of this exciting program and we believe that you will find it to be both challenging and fun. This Bronze level is your first step in reaching the Gold!

The Bronze level is designed to develop your knowledge and skills in four areas of the hobby. This is a basic level and may seem quite easy. However, you may find that this is not the case as you are required to meet strict requirements in all four areas.

Please note that the duration requirements state that you can only use a "B" impulse (or smaller) motor, and that the rockets must be recovered. There is no restriction on models or size of recovery device, though. The other motor restrictions are that you must use at least "A" impulse motors for both the booster and upper stages of the two-stage rocket, and you must use at least a "D" impulse motor for the fourth requirement.

Photo requirements may be met with one photo showing all of the rockets used in fulfilling the certification requirements, or any other number of pictures. If a picture shows more than one rocket, be sure to label the picture, indicating which rocket was used for which certification requirement. The same model may also be used for two or more certification requirements, such as parachute and streamer duration.

Many participants have customized rockets suitable for the Bronze requirements. They are welcome to use them. The same applies to those who like to use old plans. Just supply a brief description of what you used. Ready-to-fly or borrowed rockets are still excluded. While kits are the best choice for beginners, experienced builders are free to use more advanced construction methods.

If you have any questions or problems be sure to let NARTREK Base know. We will do our best to fully answer all of your questions by return mail.

All flights of this level must occur *after* you obtain this packet in order to count. If you have paid for additional levels, your Silver materials will be sent to you automatically along with your Bronze certificate. This process is repeated for each level thereafter, and there is no need to send in any additional registrations. If you have only paid for your Bronze certification, however, you must send in a new registration form for the next level. We'll remind you of this when we send you your Bronze Achievement Certificate.

If you have obtained this Bronze packet from the NAR website, you can complete the requirements and include your initial payment for the Bronze level (or all three levels) along with your Bronze flight documentation.

In closing, remember, model rocketry is more than just fun...it's great fun!

NARTREK BRONZE ACHIEVEMENT LEVEL

Requirements

- 1. Make a successful flight of at least 60 seconds duration with a model rocket you have built from an existing model rocket kit of your choice, using a parachute as the recovery device. Use a motor of no more than "B" total impulse. Someone else must time the flight using either a stop watch or a watch with a second hand. Time the flight from the moment the rocket begins to move until it lands again. Complete the requirement certification sheet. Take a photograph of your model and attach it to the certification sheet.
- 2. Make a successful flight of at least 30 seconds duration with a model rocket you have built from an existing model rocket kit of your choice, using a streamer as the recovery device. Use a motor of no more than "B" total impulse. This model can be the same one used for the parachute duration requirement, with a streamer substituted for the parachute. Someone else must time the flight in the same manner as for the parachute duration flight. Time the flight from the moment the rocket begins to move until it lands again. Complete the requirement certification sheet. If your model is the same one use for the parachute duration requirement you do not have to take another picture of it. Simply note on the requirement certification sheet that it is the same model.
- 3. Make a successful two-stage model rocket flight using at least a type "A" motor in the lower and upper stages. Use a model built from an existing model rocket kit. You can use the same model rocket you built for the parachute and/or streamer duration requirements if you add a lower stage. Complete the requirement sheet. Take a photograph of the model and attach it to the certification sheet.
- 4. Make a successful flight of a model rocket that you have built from an existing model rocket kit that is propelled by a type "D" motor, or larger. Take a photograph of your model rocket and attach it to the completed requirement certification sheet.

NOTE: **Do not send individual requirement certification sheets to NARTREK BASE!** Wait until you have completed all four requirements before submitting your documents. Be sure to submit all four requirement certification sheets.
