DART RANGE RULES:

- All rockets must be flown in accordance with the NAR Model Rocket Safety Code.
- Only 1/8A through G (less than 125 grams propellant) NAR certified motors bearing the California State Fire Marshal's seal may be used during DART launches.
- Pads must be 15 feet from people when launching up to D motors; 30 feet from people when launching E through G motors.
- Range Safety Officer will verify clear sky and range conditions prior to each launch.
- Before launching, perform Range and Sky checks, alert the crowd by announcing "Range is clear. Sky is clear. Launching!" Then proceed with a loud 5 second countdown: "5..4..3..2..1..launch".
- Do not catch rockets out of the air. You must allow them to fall to the ground.
- Children are welcome at DART launches but must be supervised at all times.

Failure to abide by these rules may result in suspension of flying privileges.

DART membership is \$20.00 per year for individual or family. Mid-year memberships are prorated (\$5 per remaining quarter(s) of the year). All renewals are in January.

DART provides launch equipment for the use of all participants. Individual personal launchers are not permitted without permission of the Range Safety Officer.

The DART launch on Fiesta Island is insured through the NAR to protect both the club and the City of San Diego. Individual coverage is extended only to members of the NAR. **Rocketeers are responsible for any damage caused by their rockets.**

Membership in the NAR or TRA is recommended but not required to participate in DART launches.
