Contest Rules: An FAI license (from any NAC) is required to fly the World Cup.

Entry Fee: Registration for the contest will be through the NARAM-63 registration portal, where the fees are specified. Entry fees includes motors for S3A, S4A, S6A, S9A, and reloads for S8E/P. Motors for S2P are the contestant's responsibility.

Flying Site: We will be using the NARAM-63 launch site in South Greenfield, MO. Refer to the NARAM-63 website www.nar.org/NARAM-63 for more information.

Contest Notes: Events S3A, S4A, S6A, and S9A will be flown with 1/2A motors ONLY.

Motors will be provided to contestants at the meet for S3A, S4A, S6A, S9A and S8E/P.

The motors provided will be: 1/2A3-4T, 1/2A3-2T, and E6-RCT

Motors for S2/P must be NAR safety certified single-use motors that contain no more than 30 gm of propellant.

Only Adrel altimeters can be used for S2/P. Adrel altimeters will be available for rental for a \$80 refundable cash only deposit, or competitor can supply their own.
